## EXPERIENCE

### **RECTOR, Good Samaritan Episcopal Church, San Diego, CA Feb. 2016-present**

I am the rector of a 350-member church with outreach and advocacy efforts and a strong ethos of hospitality and openness to seekers. I started a youth group, and I am working with other institutions to revive campus ministry at UC San Diego. After a 2016 strategic planning process, we have revamped our Sunday School, created more attractive nurseries and classrooms, extended outreach and social justice work, expanded highly attended adult formation offerings, and added weekly livestreaming and twice-daily Facebook Live Daily Office services.

### **SENIOR ASSOCIATE FOR CONGREGATIONAL DEVELOPMENT, All Saints Church, Pasadena, CA 2013-2016**

I led the first congregational development plan to improve inviting, welcoming, and connecting ministries at a 4000-member urban church. I was responsible for all New Member classes, all parish life groups and major church events. I assisted with Latino ministry by preaching or celebrating in Spanish each Sunday and doing pastoral offices in Spanish. I also oversaw the stewardship department with a \$5 million budget.

### **THEOLOGIAN IN RESIDENCE, Christ Church Bronxville, NY 2012-2013**

While pursuing a Ph.D. in systematic theology at Fordham University, I preached and celebrated in a Sarum rite style; I also led adult forums.

I taught composition, literature and technical communication courses. I designed a new Technical Communication certificate and degree curriculum. I was elected to Academic Senate and was a member of curriculum and hiring committees.
